I've been an independent councillor for two council terms and have no political party affiliation. Major concerns are to stop the juggernaut of overdevelopment, threats to open space, climate change, lack of public transport, parking, traffic management, pokies and drugs. I oppose the proposed overdevelopment of Aspendale Gardens Shopping Centre. I will work to restore village committees or similar locally-based community forums. I was President of the Patterson Lakes/Carrum Village Committee when councillors voted to disband the village committees because some did not like receiving advice from the community. They ignored a community consultation in which most participants wanted the village committees to continue. Current pro-development councillors voted to rezone the Green Wedge land between Braeside Park and Springvale Road for commercial development, and if they are re-elected the threats to the Green Wedge are likely to continue.
